CaSE Indicator #2: Wellness and PE: Cafeteria

- Grade "F" The campus is not in compliance with more than one practice required by district policies or Texas Department of Agriculture
- Grade "D" The campus is not in compliance with one practice required by district policies or Texas Department of Agriculture
- Grade "C" The campus is in compliance with all practices required by district policies or Texas Department of Agriculture
- Grade "B" The campus is in compliance with all practices required by district policies or Texas Department of Agriculture and actively encourages healthy nutrition practices with students
- Grade "A" The campus is in compliance with all practices required by district policies or Texas Department of Agriculture and encourages healthy nutrition practices with students and families and promotes these through a variety of media
