

LULAC National Scholarship Fund (LNSF)



The League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC) has considered education its number one priority since it was established in 1929. As part of LULAC's education efforts, the LULAC National Scholarship Fund (LNSF) was established in 1975 in partnership with the LULAC National Educational Service Center, Inc. (LNEESC) to provide scholarships to Hispanic students attending colleges and universities. Under the LNSF program, local LULAC Councils, in partnership with local and national businesses, award scholarships to students in their communities.

Applicants are eligible for three different types of scholarship awards ranging from \$250 to \$2,000.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for a scholarship:

- Applicants must be a U.S. citizen, legal permanent resident, or be granted Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA).
- Prospective undergraduate students must have applied to or be enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited post-secondary institution, including 2-year or 4-year colleges/universities, or vocational schools that lead to an associate's degree. Graduate students must have applied to or be enrolled as a full or part-time student at an accredited college or university.
- A student will not be eligible for a scholarship if he/she is related to a scholarship committee member, the Council President, or an individual contributor to the local funds of the Council

HOW TO APPLY:

- Download application at www.LNEESC.org/scholarships from February 15th to March 31st, 2019.
- **Dallas County applicants should submit completed and signed application** along with required docs (HS transcript with Act/SAT score(s) & GPA and a letter of acceptance from a college/university to be attending in 2019 - 2020 academic year to the following address: **LNSF Scholarship Committee, 345 S. Edgefield Ave., Dallas, TX 75208.** (NOTE: while resumes & recommendation letters are not required, they might be helpful in getting to know an applicant).
