Instructions: Lumin Education staff will use this tool to screen themselves BEFORE coming on any Lumin campuses or in-person meetings. For some staff this will be a daily screening. The question below should also be used to guide the ongoing monitoring of staff during the day as needed.

<p>Have you had <u>close contact</u>* with someone in the previous 14 days with a confirmed or presumptive diagnosis of COVID-19?</p>		
<p>Do you have any of the symptoms (listed below) <u>of greater intensity or frequency than what is normally experienced?</u></p> <p>COVID 19 Symptoms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temperature over 100.4 degrees or above • Cough • shortness of breath • sore throat • new runny nose/congestion • gastrointestinal symptoms (diarrhea, nausea, vomiting) • new loss of smell or taste • headache • new muscle aches 		

If both questions above are answered NO, you may go to work.

If either of the questions above are YES, the staff SHOULD NOT go to work and should contact their supervisor.

**Close contact is determine by an appropriate public health agency. For clarity, close contact is defined as:*

- *being directly exposed to infectious secretions, OR*
- *being within 6 feet for a cumulative duration of 15 minutes; if either occurred at any time in the last 14 days at the same time the infected individual was infectious.*
