### COVID-19 Safety Protocols – Staff Travel

This is the most updated guidance from the CDC and Dallas County Health Department for individuals traveling outside the Dallas area whether by car, boat, train, or plane.

#### Domestic Travel

- No quarantine for domestic travel required

#### International Travel

##### If not fully vaccinated

- CV19 test taken 3-5 days after returning to US
- If CV19 test is negative, then they can return to work after quarantining for 7 days from date of arrival back into the US
- If they do not want to take a CV19 test, then they must quarantine for 10 days

##### If fully vaccinated (fully vaccinated is 14 days after 2nd shot or 14 days if it is a one dose vaccine like Johnson & Johnson)

- It is recommended that a CV19 test is taken 3-5 days after returning to US (the test taken before boarding does not count)
- Fully vaccinated travelers do not have to self-quarantine following international travel. They can return to work immediately.

##### If recovered from CV19 in the past 3 months

- Travelers that have tested positive for CV19 and have completed their isolation period do not have to get a CV19 test or self-quarantine after travel

**FOR STAFF:** If a staff member travels outside the US and is not fully vaccinated and has NOT tested positive in the previous 3 months, they must get a CV19 test 3-5 days after returning to the US and quarantine for 7 days with a negative test and 10 days with a positive test.
