COVID-19 Safety Protocols – Student Travel

This is the most updated guidance from the CDC and Dallas County Health Department for individuals traveling outside the Dallas area whether by car, boat, train, or plane.

Domestic Travel

- No quarantine for domestic travel required

International Travel

If not fully vaccinated

- CV19 test taken 3-5 days after returning to US
- If CV19 test is negative, then they can return to work after quarantining for 7 days from date of arrival back into the US
- If they do not want to take a CV19 test, then they must quarantine for 10 days

If fully vaccinated (fully vaccinated is 14 days after 2nd shot or 14 days if it is a one dose vaccine like Johnson & Johnson)

- It is recommended that a CV19 test is taken 3-5 days after returning to US (the test taken before boarding does not count)
- Fully vaccinated travelers do not have to self-quarantine following international travel. They can return to work immediately.

If recovered from CV19 in the past 3 months

- Travelers that have tested positive for CV19 and have completed their isolation period do not have to get a CV19 test or self-quarantine after travel

FOR STUDENTS: If a student travels outside the US and is not fully vaccinated and has NOT tested positive in the previous 3 months, they must get a CV19 test 3-5 days after returning to the US and quarantine for 7 days with a negative test and 10 days with a positive test. The individual cannot return to the classroom until the quarantine period is over.
